Ministry Opportunities

Do you like meeting new people and enjoy helping men connect with other Christian men?

S.W.A.T. Team Coordinator

The Men's Ministry is looking for one or possibly two men to be a Team Coordinator.

A Team Coordinator would be responsible to seek out and encourage men to be members of a SWAT team. The coordinators would connect these men with established SWAT teams (who have room for additional members) or coordinators would place them in a new SWAT team.

Coordinators should be out-going, encouraging and organized.

Support for the Coordinator

The Leadership Team of the Men's Ministry will provide the Team Coordinators with a list of current SWAT teams. (The names of the team captains, members, meeting times and places and whether or not a team is open for new members)

Once Team Coordinators place a man in a SWAT team his name, addresses and email information would be provided to the Leadership Team. It would be entered in the database and the up-dated information would be given back to the coordinator.

The Leadership Team of the Men's Ministry will develop a system to provide periodic times that new SWAT Teams will be formally organized. The Team Captains to lead these new teams and the materials for start-up groups would be responsibility of the Leadership Team. The Team Coordinators would connect men interested in joining SWAT groups with these "start-up" opportunities through out the year.

It is the goal of the Leadership Team to provide "start up" opportunities for at least two new groups each quarter.

Start-up SWAT Team Captains

The Men's Ministry is looking for at least four men to be start-up SWAT Team Captains. Team Captains would take a group of men who want to be in a SWAT group and lead them through a six-week study and then back away and let the group flourish on their own.

Each start-up captain would lead two six-week studies per year.

Start-up Captains could currently be in a SWAT group, as this activity could be done along side of your existing group's meetings, or Start-up Captains could be guys not in a SWAT team, but who like meeting with men and enjoy short-term projects.

Support for Start-Up Captains

The Leadership Team of the Men's Ministry will provide Start-up Captains with the training and materials that will be used for the six-week studies. These professionally prepared materials non-threatening and very easy to use.

The Leadership Team will provide the men who are interested in joining a small group and will coordinate the first meeting with the Start-up Captain. The Leadership Team will make sure Start-up captains have the materials and training they desire
